GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF POSTERS

POSTER PREPARATION

1. At the top of the poster, please provide the title of the poster, the names of the authors, their affiliations in English, and at least one contact e-mail address. For this you should use bold lettering of about 2.5 to 3 cm size.
2. Artwork and lettering should be large and clear enough so that the poster is readable for an online presentation in an amphitheatre, on a web browser, or on a mobile phone.
3. Posters should include the confirmed abstract and title in English, Spanish or Portuguese.
4. Please remember that a poster is a visual mode of communication. Include graphics that increase the communication effectiveness and use a big font size. Note: Photographs, drawings, examples of children’s work, etc., should only be included if they relate directly to the text and if they significantly assist the readers’ understanding of the poster.
5. **A Poster Virtual space** is available in Whova’s platform for you to upload your Poster information. You can upload a cover photo for your Poster (recommended dimensions: 1000px by 600px) and upload a demo video of your Poster. **If you are not registered for ICOTS 11 yet, you need to be registered as soon as possible.**
6. **Each poster presentation will take place between 15:30 and 16:30 on Monday, September 12, and between 11:00 and 12:00 on Tuesday, September 13**, with authors required to **prepare a 2 to 3 minutes presentation of their posters** (on-site and online) that were uploaded to the Whova platform. Each poster presentation session will be followed by 30 minutes of after-posters discussions taken place either onsite or online through the Whova platform; refreshments will be served for onsite participants. Please check the timetable to see which poster session involves your poster. **Please note that all times are Argentinian local time (GMT-3).**
7. An abstract of your Poster will be included in the proceedings. An e-mail from the Editors will be sent out to you with these specific instructions.
