The 2010 International Conference on Teaching Statistics will be held in the city of Ljubljana, Slovenia, July 11-16. It is being organised by the IASE and the Statistical Society of Slovenia. The venue will be the Ljubljana Cultural and Congress Centre.

The scientific programme includes **plenary addresses**, **invited papers**, **contributed papers**, **posters** and **workshops**.

Voluntary refereeing procedures will be implemented for ICOTS8. Details of how to prepare manuscripts, the refereeing process and final submission arrangements will be announced later on the website.
