1. Working in groups of 2–5 students, conduct a mini survey on the theme of **the environment, biology or sustainable development**.
2. Summarise the survey process and the result on a poster.
3. Select the best poster in your school and send it in electronic format to your local country coordinator.
4. The winning posters will participate in the international competition, the winners of which will be displayed at the World Statistics Congress of the ISI in the Netherlands in July 2021.
