Study Problematic

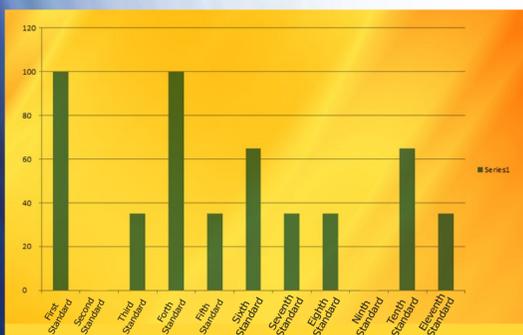
- 1- What are standards for designing Arabic language curriculum of secondary schools?

Standards for designing Arabic language curriculum:-

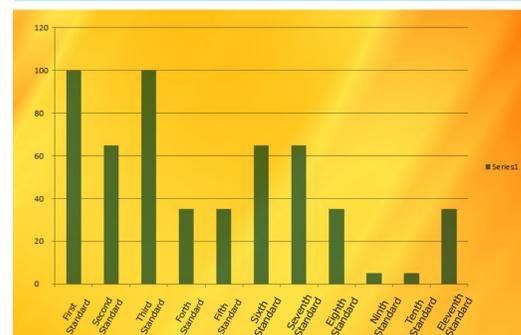
- 1- Educational objectives should be designed to help in changing students' values, morals and attitudes.
- 2- Educational experiences should be designed in light of Arabic language concepts and theories.
- 3- Educational experiences should be considered as creative thinking tools to improve Arabic language skills.
- 4- Communication skills in content should be constructed in the style of written and verbal communications.
- 5- Educational activities should be constructed to help students to develop their thinking skills and their positive values.
- 6- Educational activities should cover the starting, during, and the ending of topics.
- 7- Educational activities should be considered with different and variety types.
- 8- Teaching strategies should be based on students' performances rather than teachers' performances.
- 9- Educational aids should be constructed by adding technology.
- 10- Evaluation methods should be built to evaluate the four Arabic language skills; listening, speaking, reading and writing.
- 11- Comprehensive evaluation should be designed in Arabic language curriculums
